- Outstanding Story, Radio**—A single radio report, up to ten minutes long, on an environmental subject.
- Outstanding Beat/In-depth Reporting, Radio**—Up to five radio reports, with a combined total running time of no more than 60 minutes, on one or more environmental subjects.
- Outstanding Story, Television**—A single television report, up to ten minutes long, on an environmental subject.
- Outstanding Beat/In-depth Reporting, Television**—Up to five television reports, with a combined total running time of no more than 60 minutes, on one or more environmental subjects.
- Kevin Carmody Award for Outstanding Investigative Reporting, Print**—An investigative story, series or occasional series of up to four parts on a single environmental subject, published in a newspaper, magazine, wire service, newsletter or other print medium.
- Outstanding Explanatory Reporting, Print**—A story, series or occasional series of up to four parts that illuminates a significant and complex environmental subject, demonstrating mastery of the subject, lucid writing and clear presentation, published in a newspaper, magazine, wire service, newsletter or other print medium.
- Outstanding Beat Reporting, Print**—Up to seven stories on various environmental subjects, published in a newspaper, magazine, wire service, newsletter or other print medium.
- Outstanding Small-Market Reporting, Print**—Up to four stories on related or unrelated environmental topics by a print publication with a circulation of less than 100,000, published in a newspaper, magazine, wire service, newsletter or other print medium.
- Outstanding Online Reporting**—Up to four stories on one or more environmental subjects. They must be prepared either specifically for an online news outlet or for other media but displayed online with significant use of Internet-only tools demonstrating the power of online display.
- Outstanding Student Reporting**—A student-produced story or up to four parts of a series on a single environmental subject in print, online, or on radio or television accessible to the general public or the campus community.
